Dr. Lindeman will be working with the teachers to develop SEM activities to incorporate into their courses. The Senior Technology Seminar will have two new labs this year. Dr. Morgan has developed the curriculum for a Video Production Lab and Mr. Howard will pilot a Wireless Communications Lab in the spring.
